**Ladislav Novák: We Doubted, Hated and Despaired**

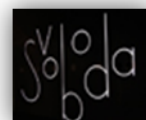

Amongst L. Novák's greatest discoveries is the technique Alchemage, in which the author used chemicals to reshape a variety of reproductions. He also developed the technique Froissage, which was also an important component of his development. Froissage is a method of collage in which the lines made by crumpling up a piece of paper are used to create a drawing. By creating and using these techniques, L. Novák greatly contributed to the development of the Czech experimental art scene. Visitors to the exhibition will see works by this artist, which have never been publicized.
